





## CSU Election procedures are changing

CSU is CITY's Student Union and aims at providing representation, support, activities and above all 'voice' to all CITY students. Its mission is to create a better experience for students at CITY College. The union is entirely run by students for students.

What changes this year with the CSU elections?

This year and from now on, elections will take place **2 times per year**During May all enrolled students are eligible to vote for 4 student union officers.

During October all students are eligible to run for class senator & all master level students can run and vote for the vice-president's position.



## CSU Elections - Academic year 2015-2016

Registering / Petitioning for Office
All 1st and 2nd year students can run for office
Candidates with intent to campaign for office, must fill out an application for election to the Department of Student Affairs.

## CSU Board - The Structure

Students that meet criteria can run and campaign for the following positions

- 1. President
- 2. Sports and Events Officer
- 3. Public Relations Officer
- 4. Welfare and Educational Officer

Applications can be submitted by Friday May 15 Candidates have one week available for campaigning. Elections will take place on week of May 25th
